Institutional capacity building

With the support of the CSF grant, the project aims to improve RWDSS's institutional capacity to manage, govern, and advocate on behalf of its constituencies, especially women and girls, by implementing efficient, standardised, results-oriented management practices. This is achieved by improving staff capacity in various management, operational, and advocacy skills.

Project results:

Empowering women and girls of Torit

Key activities include:

- Training of staff on accounting software QuickBooks, financial reporting, M&E, and procurement
- Establishing and training GBV protection watch groups on identifying and reporting GBV issues; and providing victims with access to justice, medical help
- Holding monthly and quarterly advocacy coordination and community meetings with coalition members on women's rights, protection, and empowerment
- Community radio programmes raising awareness against GBV
