## CAWDC capacity building

**With the support of the CSF grant, the project aims to strengthen its organisational capacity and advocacy strategies, such as a campaign to raise awareness of early and forced child marriage, training of community leaders, local authorities, and law enforcement agencies on gender-based violence (GBV) against women and girls.**

### **Project results:**

**Increased community awareness of GBV and the need to educate girls**

### **Key activities include:**

- Procurement and training of staff on accounting software QuickBooks
- Training of staff on advocacy, M&E, and proposal writing
- Conducting an awareness campaign on early and forced marriage
- Conducting a community workshop on GBV and girl child education
